- The Scientific Committee welcomes abstracts from delegates for **oral presentations in the Prize Paper category** at the ACOMS-2024, Chennai.
- Registration to the conference is mandatory prior to abstract submission.
- Each delegate can submit only ONE abstract.
- Abstracts are invited under the following categories
 - o Dentoalveolar Surgery / Nerve Injuries
 - Dental Implantology
 - Oral & Maxillofacial Pathology
 - Pre-prosthetic Surgery
 - Craniomaxillofacial Trauma
 - Head & Neck Oncology
 - Reconstructive Surgery
 - o Cleft & Craniofacial Anomalies
 - Orthognathic & Aesthetic Surgery
 - TMJ Disorders & Surgery
 - Head & Neck infections
 - o Research / New Technologies
 - Miscellaneous (please specify)
- Abstracts will be scrutinized by the Conference Scientific Committee for originality of topics/content.
- Acceptance and schedule will be shared by email/posted online at a later date

Abstract format

- Abstracts must be original and should not have been published elsewhere or submitted for publication in any Journal.
- Plagiarism should be avoided.
- Abstract needs to be submitted in Microsoft word format, in 12-point Times New Roman font and single spaced.
- Maximum word limit not to exceed 250.
- Abstract to be in structured form: Introduction, Methods, Results and Conclusion.

Abstracts selected for oral presentation in the Prize category will be informed after scrutiny by email. Abstracts not selected for prize category may be considered for oral/poster presentation on the recommendation of the scientific committee.

There will be a two-level evaluation for prize category presentations.

Level 1

Abstracts would undergo a blinded review to be shortlisted for consideration for prize category. At this stage the authors would be intimated to submit their complete study which would be further scrutinized and selected for the prize category.

Those papers that are not selected for prize paper category will be considered for oral /poster presentation on the recommendation of the scientific committee.

Level 2

Guidelines for manuscript submission second-round evaluation

- Full paper manuscript to be submitted
- Manuscript should be in blinded format.
- Name of the institution/Hospital where the work was conducted not to be mentioned in manuscript.
- Name of the author(s) not to be mentioned anywhere in the manuscript.
